Dr Eszter Kapusi is a postdoctoral fellow at the University of Natural Resources and Life Sciences (BOKU), Department of Applied Genetics and Cell Biology, Vienna, Austria, where she has been a researcher since 2011. She received her PhD degree from the Martin-Luther University in Halle, Germany. She then worked in the Leibniz Institute of Plant Genetics and Crop Plant Research (IPK-Gatersleben), Germany. Her main area of research is the genetic transformation of cereals (biolistic and *Agrobacterium tumefaciens*-mediated), with focus on genome editing, PhiC31 Integrase mediated recombination and molecular pharming.
